From 1st March – 31st July 2021

Registration

1. Applicants must fill in the application form and submit it together with the Pedigree Certificate to the corresponding person or the organizer.
2. In the event that the applicant is not the actual owner of the pigeons, such applicant must obtain an approval for sending the pigeons or a letter of authorization from the pigeon's owner.
3. Pigeons can be sent locally and internationally. Participant must read the terms and conditions carefully and accept the rules set out by the organization.
4. These pigeons must have an age of approximately 45-60 days. They must have attached pigeon rings allocated origin country and year 2021 properly.
5. In some countries or areas that are suspected of having pandemic. These pigeons will not be allowed to participate in Pattaya One Loft Race with no exception.
6. The registration team name needs to finalize once handed over/collected pigeons. **Changing or modifying the registered name afterwards is not allowed.**
7. After the pigeon has been sent to the loft. They will be under the supervision and training process of the organizer, the participant shall have no right to engage in a physical contact with the pigeon.
8. The organizer will cover the chip ring of each participating pigeon in order to prevent any tampering or cheating.
9. Unfit pigeons either qualifying round 120km. or in races shall be decided by the organizer as deemed appropriate.
10. The second race 430km results will be recognized by FCI Racing Pigeon Grand Prix. All participants will qualify in FCI world ranking and FCI prizes.
11. All 3-race courses being 330 km, 430 km and 530 km, the organizer will start timing the race for 2 days (race timing will start on the release date and will stop 18:00 hrs. (6.00 pm GMT+7) on the second day of the race).

Registration Fee and Prizes

1. The registration fee is **USD550 per pigeon**.
2. The participant shall pay registration fee of USD550 on a collecting date to the organizer; whereby such payment shall be made per 1 Team name. For example, TEAM DAY, there are 12 pigeons. This team should pay USD550. As well as TEAM NIGHT, there are 60pigeons. This team should pay USD550 also.
3. In the event of dead pigeon after sent to the organizer. The organizer will inform the participant of such incident; whereby the participant may replace the pigeon with a new one in acceptance period. (Between 1st March to 31st July 2021). The organizer will not be responsible for the illness, death, or loss of pigeons in any cases.
4. In case of participant who has no pigeon left for basketing in the qualifying course 120 km. **The registration fee of USD550 per team will be refunded.**
5. Upon completion of the qualifying course 120 km, the participant shall pay for the registration fees according to the number of returned pigeons, less the first pigeon registration fee that had already been paid at the beginning. This registration fee will activate qualified pigeons for 3 subsequent races. For example, sent in 12 pigeons, there are 10 pigeons returned in the qualifying course 120 km, so participant shall pay remaining 9 pigeons.
6. Freight and shipping expenses will be paid to the pigeon collector by the participant.
7. Only US dollar (USD) and Thai baht (THB) are acceptable for the payment. Any outstanding balance must be made in the same currency that was previously paid.
8. Prize money will be paid in the same currency as registration fee, after withholding tax deduction of prize money in accordance to the taxation law in Thailand.
9. The participant may request for the collection of prize money at the auction date by submitting the registration form as proof of participation.
10. For your convenience of receiving prize money from the race organizer, we require valid banking details on the registration date. Information such as SWIFT code, Account name, Account number, Bank name and address must be provided.

Qualifying course 120 km.

1. The organizer will start timing for 5 days from release day and we will stop timing on the fifth day at 18:00 hrs. (6.00 pm GMT+7).
2. Qualifying course results are available on website www.oneloftrace.live and photograph of pigeon's wing and ring number will be uploaded to www.pattayaoneloftrace.com. The organizer will issue invoices with ring number of qualified pigeons to the participants for payment.
3. For pigeons that returned **within the first 3 days** from the release date at the qualifying course 120 km, the participant is subject to pay the activation fee of all returned pigeons upon demand is not allowed.
4. For pigeons that returned **after the first 3 days** (The fourth and the fifth date of qualifying course 120km), the participant may choose whether or not to pay the activation fee in order for the pigeons to be eligible for subsequent races. If the participant decided not to pay the activation fee, such pigeons shall be disqualified and removed from all races with immediate effect. In this case, the organizer will take ownership of these pigeons and the organizer will have the right to take any actions as deemed appropriate.
5. **Activation fee payment shall be made within 5 days** from the return date of pigeons in the qualifying course 120km. In the event of failure to make such payment within the specified time frame or the amount paid is less than the issued invoices, such pigeons shall be disqualified and removed from all races with immediate effect. In this case, the organizer will take ownership of these pigeons and the organizer will have the right to take any actions as deemed appropriate.
6. In the event of loss or injury of the pigeon after the qualifying course 120 km, the registration fee will not be refunded in any cases.

TEAM PRIZES

1. All pigeons that registered in the same team name.
 - 10 pigeons can be nominated to **a Large team**
 - 6 pigeons can be nominated to **a Small team**
2. All pigeons that registered in the same team name **by 31 July 2021**. Team numbers are based on number of pigeons shipped to Pattaya, **not the remaining** pigeons after qualifying course 120km.

Example 1 TEAM DAY, there are 12 pigeons shipped to organizer. **TEAM DAY** can be nominated to participate 1 large team and also be nominated into 2 small teams, even though passed qualifying course 120km remaining 10 pigeons. **TEAM DAY** is still eligible to nominate 1 large team and 2 small teams.

Example 2 TEAM NIGHT, there are 60 pigeons shipped to organizer. **TEAM NIGHT** can be nominated to participate 6 large teams and also be nominated into 10 small teams, although passed qualifying course 120km remaining 50 pigeons. **TEAM NIGHT** is still eligible to nominate up to 6 large teams and 10 small teams or according to remaining pigeons as 5 large teams and also 9 small teams.
3. All pigeons on large team can also be nominated into Small teams. Pigeon's ring numbers in each Large team must not be duplicated. And Pigeon's ring numbers in each small team must not be duplicated.

TERMS OF TEAM PRIZES

LARGE TEAM

1. A completion of 10 pigeons registered in the same name shipped to organizer are considered as a large team, despite less than 10 pigeons have left after qualifying course 120km can nominate a large team.
2. Participant registered in the same team name with multiple completion of 10 pigeons/team. They can nominate their teams with remaining pigeons right after the qualifying course 120km. All Pigeon ring numbers that nominated to large teams must not be duplicated and need to indicate with (L-TEAM A), (L-TEAM B), (... respectively) at the end of the team's name.
3. Nominate large team(s) required to indicate ring numbers in each team to the application form and provide to the organizer within 15 days right after the qualifying course 120km.
4. In case of participant unconfirmed formation of team within a specified time frame. Forming of team will be done by the organizer who will group the ring numbers in sequence.
5. All pigeons from large teams can also be nominated into small teams. Participant is required to indicate ring numbers of 6 pigeons/ team on the application form.
6. Upon completion of the team formation to the organizer, Any changes, including re-established team's name are not allowed

SMALL TEAM

1. A completion of 6 pigeons registered in the same name shipped to organizer considered as a small team, despite, less than 6 pigeons have left after qualifying course 120km. still can nominate a small team.
2. Participant registered in the same team name with multiple completion of 6 pigeons/team. They can nominate their teams with remaining pigeons right after the qualifying course 120km. All pigeons' ring numbers that nominated to small teams must not be duplicated and need to indicate with (S-TEAM A), (S-TEAM B), (... respectively) at the end of the team's name.
3. Nominate small team(s) required to indicate ring numbers in each team to the application form, and provide to the organizer within 15 days right after the qualifying course 120km.
4. In case of participant unconfirmed formation of team within a specified time frame. Forming of team will be done by organizer who will group the ring number in sequence.
5. All pigeons from small teams can also be nominated to large teams. Participant is required to indicate ring numbers of 10 pigeons/ team on the application form.
6. Upon completion of the team formation to the organizer, Any changes, including re-established team's name are not allowed

Criteria for the winner of team prize

Only pigeons that are in the top 500 rankings of the final race at 530 km are eligible for the large team and small team prize.

In the top 500 rankings, the team with the highest number of returned pigeons will be the winner. In the event of an equal number of returned pigeons, the winning team will be determined from the lowest of total ranking of all pigeons as score from the top 500 rankings. And in the event of equal score will be determined from the 1st returned pigeon of each team. The team with the best ranking of the 1st returned pigeon will be the winner and will be awarded the team prize.

ACE PIGEON PRIZE

The Ace Pigeon must have completed all of 3 races and have the results recorded from 330 km, 430 km and 530 km. Clocking system will be on for 2 days each race start from the release date (clock system will be off at 6.00pm on the second day of race)

Criteria for the winner of Ace Pigeon

Ace pigeons, they required to have scored from 3 races, 330km, 430km and 530km. Therefore, the pigeon with the lowest total score from 3 races will be the winner. The score of each race will using the following formula.

$$\text{Score} = \frac{\text{Rank} \times 1,000}{\text{Basketed pigeons} \times \text{Distance}}$$

Auction and awards

1. All pigeons in the top 500 rankings from the final race 530 km need to be auctioned.
2. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th of Ace Pigeons need to be auctioned.
3. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd prize winners of 330 km and 430 km need to be auctioned.
4. Proceeds from the auction shall be shared between the owner (60%) and the organizer (40%).
5. Auction proceeds is in THAI BAHT only
6. All remaining pigeons from the auction, the pigeon's owner may purchase their pigeons at 40% of the bid price. Any pigeon without a bidder, the organizer will have the right to the pigeon's ownership and will proceed further with actions as deemed appropriate to the organization.
7. The pigeon's owner shall be responsible for withholding taxes or expenses pertaining to the prize money or proceeds in accordance to the taxation law in Thailand.
8. In any pertaining freight expenses shall be responsible by the bidder.
9. The organizer will use the foreign exchange rate indicated by the Bank of Thailand.
10. For all of overseas pigeon with ranking 501 onward will have to participate in the auction on the website. All proceeds from the auction will be allocated between the owner (60%) and the organizer (40%).

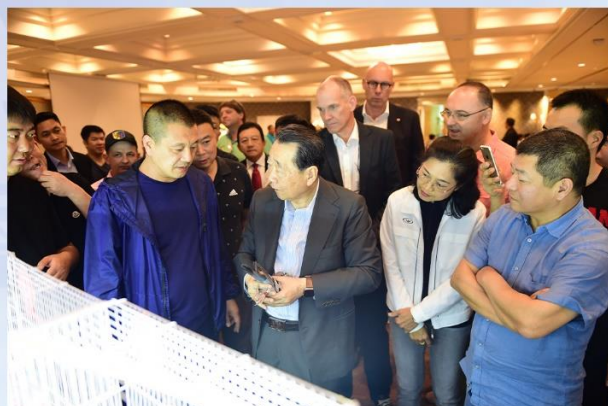
